History

Traditionally within Christianity it is believed that officially the chaplaincy has its origin in the person of San Martin de tour. He was born on 316 DC in Pannonia in a province Called Romania, like his parents, Martin as a young man followed the polytheistic religion at the age of 16 he enlisted in the Roman military forces where he stood out as a soldier and officer. At the age of 21 The troop was sent to Amiens de Gaul (today France) While Martin was there on a cold night he went for a walk and noticed a beggar man begging for help but being ignored by passers-by, Martin had nothing to offer but without thinking he approached the beggar and after that he cut his cloak in two he offered half the man and he kept the rest of it

That same night Martin had a vision where it was revealed to him that this beggar was actually Jesus Christ.

This vision motivated him and he gave his life to Christ and later he was baptized by Bishop Hilario by sharing their testimony many people accepted Christianity and later the middle of the cloak St. Martin de Tour retained became a relic and a reminder symbol of the encounter he had with the Lord Jesus Christ that half of the layer was stored in a trunk called capella, hence the term chapel, which literally means the place where the layer is currently.

The person in charge of protecting the cape was the capellanus that in Spanish is Capellanes which they are in charge of sharing and offering the love of God to all those who are in need.

The founder of Capellanes de Florida is Dr. Juan Carlos Amnesty. Ph D. president of central christian university.
